Funky-looking turtle added to endangered list

The Mary River turtle, located in the river with the same name in Queensland, Australia, has recently been listed as number 29 on a list of the world's 100 most endangered reptiles. This funky-looking turtle doesn't have a large family, as there are only an estimated 136 animals left in the wild.

The list of endangered reptiles was recently released by the Zoological Society of London as part of their Evolutionarily Distinct and Globally Endangered (EDGE) of Existence programme.
